Join Us to Discuss Design Improvements to Blue Hill Avenue Traffic

A Design Public Hearing will be held by MassDOT to discuss the proposed Blue Hill Avenue and Warren street traffic signal improvements.

Come join the conversation at the **Urban League of Eastern MA**, 88 Warren St, 2nd floor on Tuesday September 12th, 6:30PM.

PURPOSE: To provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed improvements. All views and comments made at the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

PROPOSAL: Consists of improving safety and operations for all



users; i.e. bicyclists, pedestrians, and motor vehicles and transit users. The project will connect traffic signals along the Blue Hill Avenue and Warren Street corridors to the Boston Transportation Department (BTD) Traffic Control Center at City Hall, allowing real-time adjustments of traffic signal timing for operational and incident management. Although bicycle and pedestrian accommodations are presents along the corridor, the existing non-compliant wheelchair ramps and pedestrian crossings will be reconstructed.
