P-EBT is a program created to provide funds for families with infants and children 0-5 years old who are on SNAP to help buy more food during the COVID-19 pandemic.

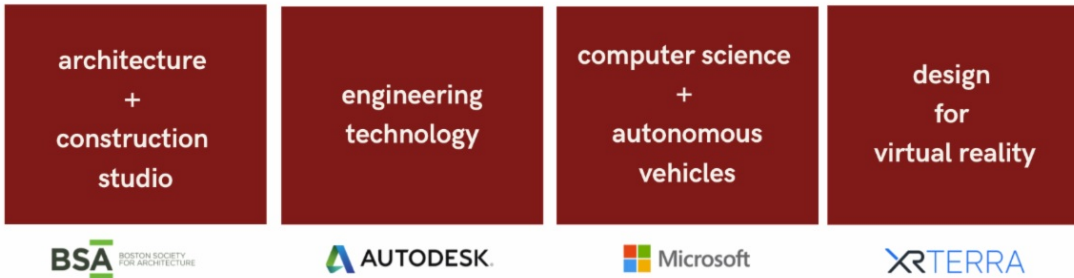

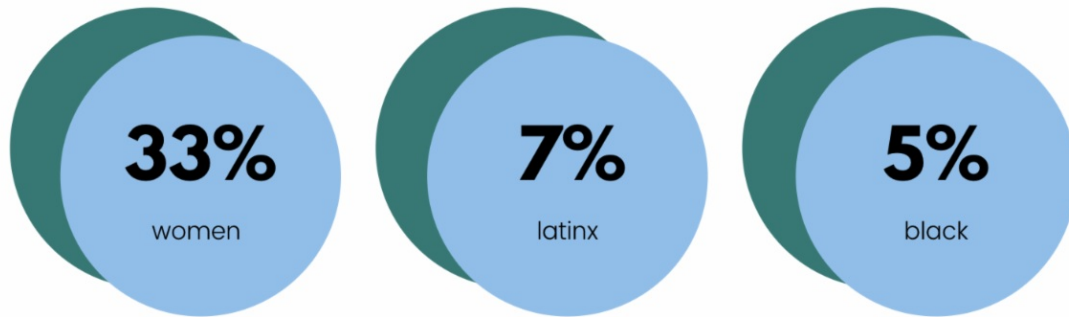

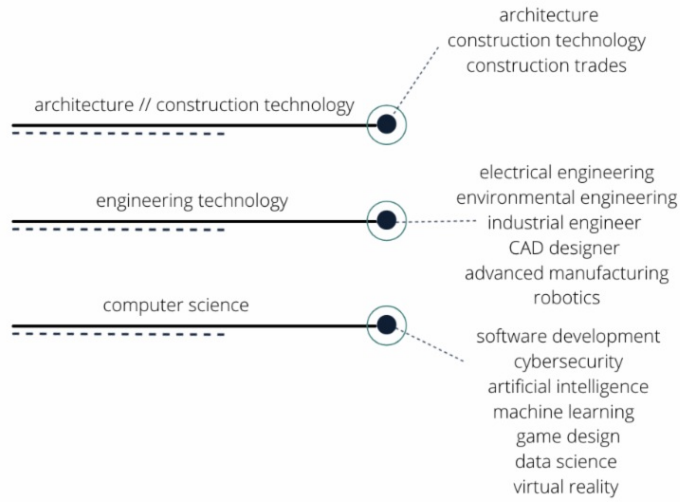

In addition to our summer studios, we are also accepting applications for our Y13 Fellowship. This year we are piloting offering housing to all accepted students so they will have the opportunity to live in our Living Learning Lab. We are currently accepting rising seniors and recent Boston graduates for this early college pathway. Students are being

accepted on a rolling basis until June 30 and have the opportunity to try out Digital Ready during the summer before making the commitment to the yearlong fellowship.
